- Day 3: Drive from Manali to Kaza via Kunzum La (Overnight in Kaza)
- Day 4: Acclimatization trek in Spiti Valley (Overnight in Kaza)
- **Day 5:** Drive to Kibber, trek to Chichim Bridge (Overnight in Kibber homestay)
